



Risk Management Workshop

Objectives

The objectives of the workshop are:

- To enable delegates to appreciate the need for management of risk
- To provide a framework for the management of risk
- To enable delegates to gain practical experience of the management of risk
- To enable delegates to make effective use of the management of risk on return to the workplace.

Workshop Style

The workshop will be highly interactive. Following an introductory session, short input sessions will be provided followed by delegates being given the opportunity to put into practice the lessons learned in the preceding topic.

Illustrations of risk management from the real world will be provided and delegates will be encouraged to contribute examples and illustrations from their own experiences.

The workshop will make reference to current Risk Management best practice, as promoted by the OGC.

Course Content

- Introduction and Objectives

This session will introduce the workshop, outline the content and have delegates introduce themselves.

Define a Framework

This short session will cover the need for a management of risk Framework. It will emphasise the need to build upon core Principles and to develop an organisation specific approach for Risk Management. It will also cover the importance of recognising the impact of risk across the organisation.

Risk Identification

This session will explore approaches to risk identification.

Case Study Risk Identification

The case study will be introduced and delegates will work in groups to identify risk associated with the case study situation.

Risk Assessment

This session will cover techniques available for risk assessment. It will emphasise the need to understand the difference between probability and impact and how they relate to one another.

Case Study Risk Assessment

Delegates will be asked to conduct risk assessment for the case study.

Identify Responses

The session will explore the need to set acceptable levels of risk, relating to risk appetite and risk tolerance. The session will then work through potential responses:

- Reduction
- Removal
- Transfer
- Retention
- Share

Case Study Identify Responses

Delegates will be asked to identify potential responses to some of the risks identified earlier.

Implement Responses and Monitor Effectiveness

This session will consider the work involved to implement responses. This will include impact on plans, resources, costs etc. The session will also cover approaches to monitoring the effectiveness of responses that have been put in place.

Case Study Implement Responses and Monitor Effectiveness

Delegates will be asked to select appropriate responses from those identified earlier. They will determine the impact of the responses and establish how they intend to monitor the effectiveness of the responses which have been implemented.

Workshop Summary

This session will summarise the main messages of the day and will also identify significant findings of the case study activities.
